New Textures for Marimba - Composition, Arrangement, and Performance

- Percussion lecture and **composition workshop**
- 60-90 minutes
- In-person
- Designed for music students in high school and college

Adapting beloved classics of the orchestral world for the marimba has revealed a brilliant array of textures on the instrument. Explore the unique properties of the marimba and how they can be expressed through original composition, ingenious arrangement, and inspired performance. Composers may submit scores in advance for the Abaido-Brown Duo to workshop and perform in this session.

Foreground, Background - Communicating in an Ensemble

- · Chamber music workshop and masterclass
- 60 minutes
- In-person
- Suitable for students of all ages

In the course of a single performance, each of us acts as a soloist, collaborator, and accompanist. Learn how to define your place and flow from one role to another in a hands-on examination of chamber music relationships. All student ensemble types are encouraged to participate in this chamber music masterclass, 2 to 3 groups will be invited to perform in this session.

Performance Psychology - How do we get Better at the Act of Performing?

- Lecture, with possible masterclass
- 45 minutes
- In-person or online
- Suitable for students of all ages

As presented on the World Percussion Group's 2023 European Tour, William takes a deep dive into the fears and triumphs our minds experience during a performance. A short solo student solo performance is encouraged to help serve as a case study for this nuanced topic.

Pre-Concert Talk – Behind the Music

Before the Abaido-Brown Duo takes stage to play their first note, take time to reach behind the curtain and hear how the concert comes together. Learn about the composers we've selected, the works we will play, peek inside the lid of the piano, and get a tour of the marimba.
